SUBJECT: Space Needle Ceremonies, Monday, May 22

You are cordially invited to attend special ceremonies on Monday, May 22 at 11 a.m. that officially observe the start of construction on the dramatic, 600-foot Space Needle that will be one of the landmarks of our World's Fair. The ceremonies will be held at the site of the Space Needle, near the intersection of Fourth Avenue North and John Street, on the east side of the fair site.

The ceremonies will last approximately 40 minutes.
